- Make a concentrated effort to use others' correct names and pronouns
- Volunteer for the LOSS Team
- Help promote access to comprehensive sex ed



CALL TO ACTION

- Store firearms and medications, not accessible to those in crisis
- Share social media distribution of firearms safety video from CHP's facebook page
- Op-Ed from firearms owner on safe storage
- Letter to the Editor on suicide prevention
- Share suicide prevention resources and firearms safety video on website
- Email marketing such as electronic newsletters



CALL TO ACTION

- Donate for financial assistance for people with serious thoughts of suicide
- Advocate with your employer and partner organizations to have Suicide Prevention Policies, Training Plans and Response Teams
- Commit to Safe Messaging Pledge from Media Partners
- Commit to Supporting Veterans and Suicide Prevention Pledge
